

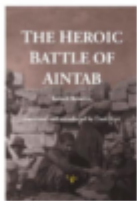

The Turkish-French war of 1920-1921 took place between the Turkish-Kurdish Nationalist forces and French troops in Aintab, modern day Gaziantep. The war started on April 1, 1920, and ended with the city's surrender to the French military forces on February 9, 1921.

Ümit Kurt as he explores the war based on eyewitness accounts recorded by activist Nevah Babikian in *The Heroic Battle of Aintab*. Dr. Kurt will present his English translation of his unique work that portrays the struggle for survival of returning genocide survivors as they tried to negotiate a path between their former executioners and an invading French army.

Ümit Kurt is a native of Aintab. He received his Ph.D. from the Department of History at Clark University. He is a former post-doctoral fellow at Harvard University and the current Professorial Fellow at Jerusalem's Van Leer Institute. He has taught at Rutgers University, Seton Hall University, California State University and Clark University. He is the Kazan Visiting Professor at Fresno State University.
