# ARPA Institute Panel Discussion

## “Impact of Digital Health Projects in Healthcare of Armenia”

Panelists: Kristine Poghosyan, Ruzanna Movsesyan, Emin Manukyan and Kristine Sargsyan.

**Abstract:** Armenia can leapfrog the US and Europe with a workforce to build the necessary infrastructure for Electronic Health Records (EHR), which is already being widely implemented. The Avetis Health Informatics Fellowship is the first health informatics training program in Armenia, consisting of a bootcamp, an individualized training program, a capstone, and a scholarly project. In this panel, the first cohort of the Avetis fellows will present their work including: (1) digital health tools such as Short Message Service reminders, usage of applications and some other digital solutions to improve International Normalized Ratio control in patients who take lifelong warfarin, (2) an electronic system for quantification, providing, and storing lab supplies was created and put into operation for tuberculosis supply management, (3) integration of laboratory data to the unified system for all active labs to be integrated into the HER of Armenia, and (4) health informatics tools for testing, management and certification of Continuing Medical Education for healthcare professionals in Armenia.

**Kristine Poghosyan, MD, MPH,** is a Fellow of the Avetis Health Informatics Fellowship in Armenia. She is also a cardiologist at Nork-Marash Medical Center. Dr. Poghosyan has an MD from Yerevan State Medical University (YSMU) and MPH from the American University of Armenia (AUA).



**Ruzanna Movsesyan MS, MBA,** Fellow of the Avetis Health Informatics. She is also chief health IT specialist at National Centre of Pulmonology, and Consultant for training of the EHR with the Breast Cancer and Breast Mammography Screening Pilot Program for Primary Care Physicians. Ruzanna has an MS in Engineer Programming from State Engineering University of Armenia and MBA in Healthcare Management from YSMU.



**Emin Manukyan, Ph.D.,** is a Fellow of the Avetis Health Informatics Fellowship in Armenia. He is a senior developer at National E-Health Operator, a Closed Joint Stock Company in Armenia. Emin has his Ph.D. in Software Engineering, Control and Automation from National Polytechnic University of Armenia.



**Kristine Sargsyan MD, MPH,** is a Fellow of the Avetis Health Informatics Fellowship in Armenia. She works at the National Institute of Health, the Ministry of Health, and Glasbo Diagnostic Clinic. Dr. Sargsyan is an endocrinologist with an MD from YSMU and MPH in Epidemiology from AUA.



**Dr. Shant Shekherdimian MD,** Drexel University in Philadelphia, Pa. He has had residency in general surgery at UCLA and a fellowship in pediatric surgery at the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, Canada. Shant is the Promise Institute Inaugural Associate Director for Healthcare Outreach and Associate Professor of Pediatric Surgery, UCLA Department of Surgery. He is involved in projects with the aim to improve pediatric care in Armenia and now serves as an advisor to the Health Care Minister of Armenia.
