**American University of Armenia (AUA)**

AUA ([www.aua.am](http://www.aua.am)) invites applications for the position of **President of the University**. AUA is a privately endowed independent American institution of higher education in the Republic of Armenia. AUA is affiliated with the University of California and is accredited by the WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC), 985 Atlantic Avenue, #100, Alameda, CA 94601. Presently it offers 6 undergraduate and 11 graduate degree programs in five colleges to over 2,000 students and operates six active research centers and an Open Education program with seven regional centers offering credit-bearing education courses to more than 5,000 students annually. Plans are in progress to increase the physical facilities, academic programs, and student population in the next five years.

**AUA Mission:** The American University of Armenia aims to have an impact on students and the community as a center of academic excellence, innovation, inquiry, and diversity that contributes to the further development and advancement of Armenia, the region and the world through teaching, research and outreach, fostering creativity, leadership, integrity, and community service.

**Responsibilities:** Reporting directly to the President, the position will provide leadership in academic planning, development, assessment, and implementation. The successful candidate will have a commitment and capacity to continuously evaluate and enhance the University's academic and research programs to ensure excellence, growth and competitiveness; manage the academic budgeting process; promote the university's core values; plan and strategically establish positive relationships with faculty, staff, students, community, government and private sectors; and lead organizational change initiatives using data-driven decision-making methodology. The person will also be responsible for representing the university in scholarly forums, fostering an international education and other matters germane to the growth of AUA.

**Qualifications:** Candidates must have strong academic and leadership credentials; an earned doctorate degree; evidence of successful teaching, administrative and managerial abilities; a strong track record of research as evidenced by scholarly publications, senior faculty and academic management experience in U.S. educational institutions; financial management skills; knowledge of grant applications and administration. Previous experience in conducting academic studies in an international setting and knowledge of Armenia is desirable but not required.
