The current situation, future growth potential, and sustainability of the economy of Armenia

Abstract: Armenia has seen impressive economic growth with storng macroeconomic indicators in the past two years, showing resilience despite the multiple shocks of the pandemic and the attemment of the Ad-Ag way, in aborting o exist 20,000 Artisate despies. There is en length id evelopment in the high-tech, construction, and services sectors, as well as relative stability in banking. Yet, growth is forecast to slow down in the near term, as capital inflows decline and business activity moderates. Structurally, incentivizing balanced and inclusive growth should be the key to generating well-paid jobs and reducing regional inequalities. Externally, Armenia is subject to geogolitical and gene o-conomic uncertainties, affecting foreign investment and disapora engagement. Domestic market growth would play a role in the longer-term sustanability, Leveraging the current capacity and sustaining the growth momentum, a pragmatic long term development model may be needed.
